By-Law for amendment

Current: b) A player meeting league requirements and not previously signed on a roster may spare up to four times for any given team. When a spare is used, they must sign the score sheet as well as print their name legibly and add the word SPARE beside the signature.

Amendment: b) A player meeting league requirements and not previously signed on a roster may spare up to four times for any given team. When a spare is used, they must sign the score sheet as well as print their name legibly and add the word SPARE beside the signature. A current rostered player from another team may spare up to 2 times for a team in their same division or higher ONLY. When this spare is used, they must sign the score sheet as well as print their current team name legibly and add the word PICK-UP (or SPARE) beside their signature.

Please consider this amendment request for next year's league. I thought using "pick-up" rather than spare could distinguish between an actual spare. Thank you.
